Throw-in Foul

A throw in foul is a personal foul committed, when the game clock shows 2:00 minutes or less in the fourth quarter and each overtime, by a defensive player on an opponent on the court when the ball is out of bounds for a throw in and still in the hands of the referee or at disposal of the player taking the throw in.

Penalty

The player who was fouled shall be award only 1 free throw, regardless whether the offending team is already in the team penalty situation.

The game shall be resumed with a throw in by the non-offending team from the place nearest to where the foul happened.
